

What steps does the **Wind Racers Club Aruba** take towards a Sustainable and Clean Competition?

We **REDUCE** the amount of material being used

We **RE-USE** as much as possible

We **RECYCLE** When there is no other alternative we use materials that can be recycled

We reduce the amount of plastics being used during the competition.

No Styrofoam will be used. We discourage the use of single-use plastics.

The Wind Racers Club Aruba organization opts for drinks in cans instead of drinks in plastic bottles. (Glass is not allowed on the beach).

At the “Waterstation” free chilled water will be available for people who bring their own refillable bottle.

Lunches will be wrapped in paper, no boxes or Styrofoam necessary.

We will reduce the amount of paper being used.

Only the (smaller) registration-form and sailing instructions will be on paper. The paper being used is made of 100% recycled paper.

At the competition-site on different locations there are bins to separate waste. When the competition is over the contents will be brought to different locations to be reused / recycled by Plastic Beach Party.

The signaling-horns are manually operated or by air-pressure and can be re-used year after year.

Signs are printed on recycled paper or where necessary produced in a way they can be re-used next year.

The awards are made from recycled and / or re-used materials by Plastic Beach Party.

Please take notice of Rule 55 of the ISAF regulations which states: “A competitor shall not intentionally put trash in the water” No discharge from boats will be allowed.

At the end of the day please only rinse your gear with water, don't use soap (or only the bio-degradable kind).

We have introduced a Green Team. If you have any questions or need information about our Sustainability project you can contact them or visit the information stand on the site.

At the end of every day we do an extra clean-up to assure the beach is left as beautiful as it was and maybe even cleaner than we found it 😊 Anybody who wants to participate is welcome!
